In accordance with the Federal Law "On Banks and Banking Activity" the General License for conducting banking transactions is granted to

hereinafter referred to as the "Bank".

The Bank is authorized to conduct the following banking transactions in Russian rubles and in foreign currencies:

- 1. Taking personal and corporate funds on deposit (call deposits and time deposits).
- 2. Allocating funds of individuals and corporates that have been taken on deposit (call deposits and time deposits) on its own behalf and at its own expense.
- 3. Opening and maintaining bank accounts for individuals and corporates.
- 4. Performing transfers of funds by order of individuals and corporates including authorized correspondent banks and foreign banks to/from their bank accounts.
- 5. Collecting monetary funds, bills of exchange, payment and settlement documents and providing cash banking services to individuals and corporates.
- 6. Purchasing and selling foreign currency on a cash and non-cash basis.
- 7. Issuing bank guarantees.
- 8. Performing transfers of funds without opening bank accounts, including transfers of electronic payment means (with an exception of postal money orders).
